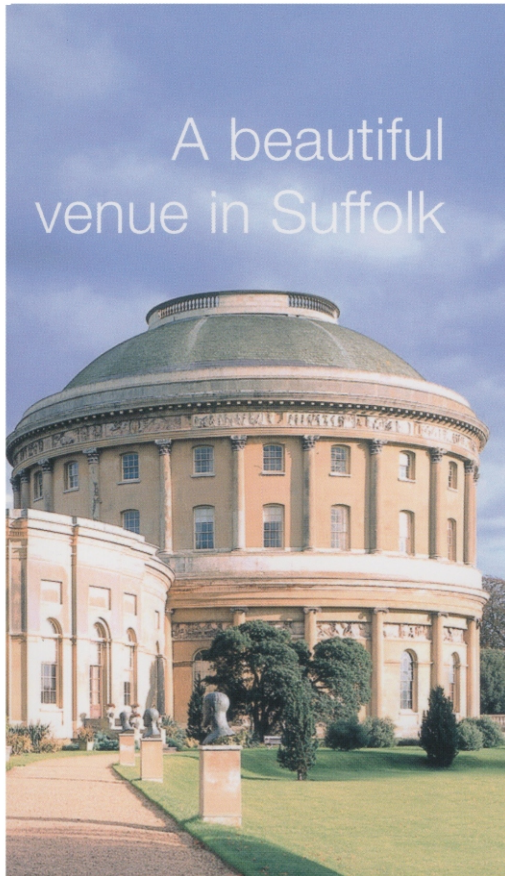

THE WEST WING AT ICKWORTH

*Elegant, Inspiring, Beautiful, Stimulating,
Historic*

The West Wing is part of Ickworth House, created in 1795 by the eccentric 4th Earl of Bristol to display collections gathered from all over Europe. To day Ickworth House with its vast central Rotunda and curved corridors presents collections of paintings including work by Titian, Valasquez and Gainsborough, George silver and Regency furniture. The house is surrounded by 1800 acres of gardens and Pleasure Grounds.

The Ickworth Estate was home to the Hervey family for 600 years. It was passed to the National Trust by Treasury Transfer in 1956 in lieu of death duties. The shell of The West Wing of Ickworth House was completed in 1841, but work to finish it internally began in 2004 when the National Trust started development.

Dinner at The West Wing at Ickworth including a, private, guided tour of the house will cost approximately £45-00 per person.
